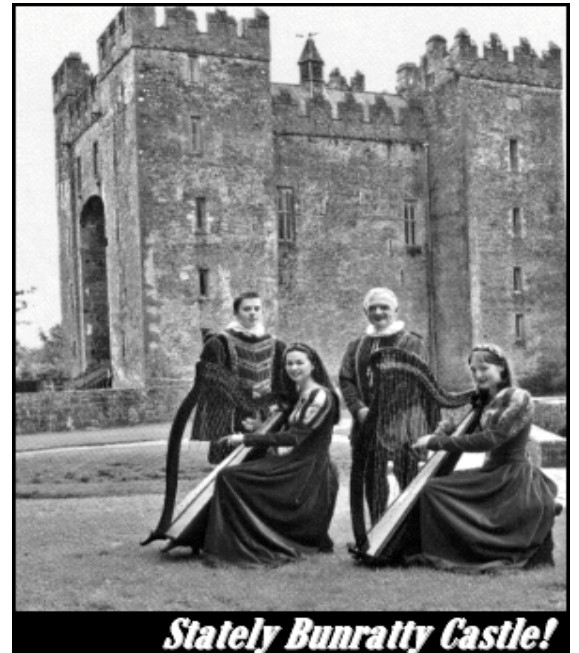

OUR CUSTOM TOUR OF IRELAND ITINERARY:

MAR 22 - BOSTON-SHANNON: Depart Boston's Logan International Airport aboard our non-stop Aer Lingus flight to Shannon, Ireland with full meal and beverage service, as well as stereo headsets, available in flight.

MAR 23 - ARRIVE SHANNON and KILLARNEY: Morning arrival in Shannon Airport. We will be met by our Tour Escort, who will look after all our needs during the tour and will assist with our transfer. After boarding our private, deluxe motorcoach, we will take the short drive to Bunratty Castle, Ireland's most complete medieval castle which was rebuilt in 1353. Following our tour of the castle, we will visit Bunratty Folk Park, where we will experience some of the local Irish history. From Bunratty, we will continue to Killarney in County Kerry and check-in at the *Killarney Court Hotel* (or similar) which is located near the center of Killarney. The remainder of the afternoon is at leisure to familiarize ourselves with our surroundings. Dinner and overnight at our hotel. (D)

MAR 24 - RING OF KERRY: Full Irish breakfast at our hotel. Today, we will enjoy a full-day of guided sightseeing of the picturesque Ring of Kerry, the popular scenic drive on the southwestern tip of Ireland. The route covers the 100-mile circular road, starting from Killarney, heading around the Iveragh Peninsula and passing through Kenmare, Sneem, Waterville (*favourite holiday spot of Charlie Chaplin that now has a statue of him to commemorate his love of the place*), Cahersiveen and Killorglin. Popular points include Muckross House (near Killarney), Staigue stone fort and Derrynane House, home of Daniel O'Connell. Just south of Killarney, Ross Castle, Lough Leane, and Ladies View (*a panoramic viewpoint*), all located within Killarney National Park, are major attractions located along the Ring. Return to our hotel in Killarney for dinner and overnight. (FB, D)

MAR 25 - BLARNEY, MIDLETON and WATERFORD: Full Irish breakfast at our hotel. After hotel-check-out, we will travel to the Blarney Castle ruins for a chance to kiss the world-famous Blarney Stone, which is said to bestow eloquence on all who dare. Next, we will continue-on to Midleton and one of the highlights of our tour - *The Old Midleton Whiskey Distillery* - where Jameson Whiskey is made. We will learn about the distilling process and taste this world famous Irish whiskey! After this fabulous experience, we will next travel to Waterford, and check-in at the *Days Hotel Waterford* (or similar). Following dinner at our hotel, we will have the evening at leisure to explore this traditional Irish coastal town. Overnight. (FB, D)

MAR 26 - WATERFORD and DUBLIN: Full Irish breakfast at our hotel, followed by hotel-check-out. This morning, we will enjoy a tour of the Waterford Crystal Factory and Museum. This world-renowned crystal manufacturer will give us some historical background on and allow us to purchase crystal tax-free! We will then board our motorcoach for a trip to the scenic Wicklow Mountains. In Glendalough, we will stop to visit the 6th century monastic site known as "St. Kevin's Kitchen and have a chance to enjoy the beautiful scenery. We will then continue our drive through the Wicklow Mountains on into Dublin. Upon arrival in Dublin, we will check-in at the *Jury's Inn Custom House* (or similar) centrally located along the River Liffey in Dublin. Dinner is at the hotel this evening. Overnight. (FB, D)

MAR 27 - DUBLIN'S FAIR CITY: Full Irish breakfast at our hotel. A half-day guided panoramic sightseeing tour of Dublin including: O'Connell Street, the Customs House, Phoenix Park, Viking Dublin, Trinity College and more is on today's excursion. After the tour, we will have the remainder of the afternoon at leisure to stroll through the streets of Dublin, do some independent sightseeing, or shop for that very special gift. Dinner at our hotel this evening. Overnight. (FB, D)

MAR 28 - DUBLIN-BOSTON: Following our full Irish breakfast and hotel check-out, we will transfer to the Dublin airport to board our return non-stop Aer Lingus flight to Boston with full meal and beverage service, as well as stereo headsets, available in flight. (FB)

After processing, the request, any additional deviation expenses (car rental, train, hotel, etc.) must be paid, in full, to the Retail Department of Durgan Travel Service at the time of reservation.
