OUR POLAND PANORAMA ITINERARY

DAY 1 - BOSTON-INTERMEDIATE CITY-WARSAW: Depart from Boston's Logan Airport to Warsaw on an overnight flight (*via an intermediate city*) with full meal and beverage service, as well as stereo headsets, while aloft.

DAY 2 - WARSAW: Transfer to the *Novotel Centrum Hotel* (or similar). Meet our Tour Host in the hotel lobby at 6:00 p.m. for our "Welcome Dinner" and folklore performance. (D)

DAY 3 - WARSAW: Highlights of our half-day tour include Old Town, rebuilt with great reverence after World War II, the beautiful Old Market Square, the Barbican and Medieval defensive walls. Continue to the Jewish Ghetto Memorial dedicated to the victims of Nazi brutality. Then, we will drive along the Royal Route, important for its place in Polish history. Next stop is Lazienki Park and its elegant sculpture of Chopin surrounded by rose bushes. After lunch, an excursion to the Royal Castle - former residence of Polish kings. (BB, L)

DAY 4 - WARSAW-CZESTOCHOWA-AUSCHWITZ-KRAKOW: After breakfast, depart for Krakow via Czestochowa. En route we will visit the Jasna Gora monastery and its famous shrine which houses the Black Madonna, venerated by some as the "Queen of Poland". Lunch in Czestochowa. Continue to Krakow via Auschwitz Martyrdom Museum, site of the dreadful Nazi death camp. Overnight in Krakow. (BB, L)

DAY 5 - KRAKOW: Our morning city tour includes the fortified castle and cathedral complex of Wawel Hill, Old Town, and St. Mary's Church with the masterpiece altar carved by Wit Stwosz. In the afternoon, we will visit Wieliczka Salt Mine, a splended 3-mile-long underground complex of chambers, chapels and statues sculptured from salt. Dinner at local restaurant. (BB, D)

DAY 6 - ZAKOPANE-KRAKOW: Full-day trip to Zakopane. Sightseeing of Zakopane and its quaint wooden architecture. A ride to the top of Mt. Gubalowka provides a breathtaking view of the Tatras. Dinner with folklore show at the local restaurant. Overnight in Krakow. (BB, D)

DAY 7 - KRAKOW-WARSAW-TORUN: Morning departure for Warsaw. After lunch, continue to Torun, an historic town on the banks of the Vistula River. (BB, L)

DAY 8 - TORUN-GDYNIA: A morning city tour of Torun's marvelous Gothic architecture includes the birthplace of Nicolaus Copernicus on St. Anne's Street. Study the Old Town Square, Town Hall, nearby "Pod Gwiazda" house, and much more. After lunch, departure for Gdynia. (BB, L)

DAY 9 - GDYNIA: Morning tour of Gdansk, Gdynia and Sopot. The Old Town area of Gdansk, with its Town Hall, Artus Court, Great Arsenal, St. Mary's Church and lovely burgher's houses, is a masterpiece of post-war reconstruction. Continue to Oliwa for a concert on the cathedral's famous pipe organ. Afternoon free for private exploration and leisure. Lunch at a local restaurant. (BB, L)

DAY 10 - GDYNIA-MALBORK-OLSZTYN: Today we leave for the Mazurian Lake district, one of Poland's favorite vacation areas. Along the way, stop in Malbork, famous for the massive Teutonic Knights' castle - among the best-preserved Medieval structures in Central Europe. Picnic and overnight in Olsztyn. (BB, L)

DAY 11 - OLSZTYN-WARSAW: After breakfast, departure for Warsaw. On the way we'll stop in Olsztynek, the site of an outdoor museum of folk architecture. Included is a "Farewell Dinner" with folklore show at a local restaurant. (BB, D)

DAY 12 - WARSAW-INTERMEDIATE CITY-BOSTON: After breakfast and hotel check-out, transfer to the airport for our homeward flight to Boston (*via an intermediate city*) with full meal and beverage service, as well as stereo headsets, while aloft.. (BB)
