OUR "NORTHERN CAPITALS" ITINERARY:

DAY 1 – BOSTON~COPEHAGEN: Depart Boston's Logan International Airport aboard our regularly scheduled transatlantic flight to Copenhagen (via intermediate stop) with meal and beverage service, as well as stereo headsets, while in flight.

DAY 2 – COPENHAGEN: Upon arrival we will be met by our Tour Escort, who will help us board our private motorcoach for transfer to the *Comfort Hotel Vesterbro (or similar)* for check in. Dinner is at a local restaurant this evening. Overnight at our hotel. (D)

DAY 3 – COPENHAGEN: After breakfast at our hotel, we will enjoy a half-day excursion to view city highlights, such as the Church of Our Savior, Stock Exchange, National Museum Royal Theatre, and Christiansborg Palace. Entrance and a guided tour of the Royal Reception Rooms are followed by a panoramic view of the Little Mermaid. Lunch (*on our own*) is followed by an afternoon of leisure to explore Copenhagen. Tonight, visit Tivoli Gardens (mid-Apr. to mid-Sep.), the city's colorful amusement park. (B)

DAY 4 – GOTHENBURG, SWEDEN~OSLO, NORWAY: From Elsinore beneath Hamlet's Kronborg Castle, board your ferry for Helsingborg. Then, drive to Gothenburg, Sweden's thriving second-largest city. Admire its beautiful parks, botanical gardens, and well-kept canals during your orientation tour. Highlight is a visit to Gothenburg's famous indoor food market to taste local snacks at some of the stalls. In the afternoon, continue along the Skagerrak coastline to Norway. Evening arrival in Oslo, where we will check in to the *Thon Hotel Panorama (or similar)*. Dinner will be at a local restaurant. (B, D)

DAY 5 – OSLO: After breakfast, we embark on a half-day guided sightseeing tour, including views of the National Theater, Parliament, The Royal Palace and Frogner Park, and entrance to City Hall. Optional tours are available in the afternoon and evening. Overnight at our hotel. (B)

DAY 6 – OSLO~KARLSTAD~ESKILSTUNA~STOCKHOLM: Trace the King's Road, an ancient trade link between the northern capitals connecting Oslo, Stockholm, Turku, Helsinki, and St. Petersburg. Cross the Swedish border to scenic Värmland, beautifully described in Selma Lagerlöf's *Gösta Berlings Saga*, on the way to Karlstad on Lake Vänern. Pass the ancient garrison town of Örebro and modern Eskilstuna, known for its stainless steel, and proceed to Stockholm, where we will check in to our hotel, *Best Western Kom (or similar)*. (B)

DAY 7 – STOCKHOLM: Stockholm, scene of Stieg Larsson’s Millennium, is settled on 14 islands between Lake Mälär and the Baltic Sea. Sightseeing with a Local Guide features the Royal Palace; Riddarholm Church, and a walk through the Old Town. Also visit the blue and gold chambers in the City Hall, where the annual Nobel Prize banquet is held. Choose from our exciting optional excursions to make the most of your stay. (B)

DAY 8 – STOCKHOLM~HELSINKI: After breakfast and hotel check-out, the morning is at leisure. After lunch (*on our own*), we are escorted by to our port transfer. We will sail overnight to Helsinki on a high-quality mini-cruise and passenger transport ferry service including regular cruise-line activities. Dinner will be served onboard the ferry. (B, D)

DAY 9 – HELSINKI: Upon arrival, we will be met and guided on a half-day tour, including outside views of City Hall, Parliament House, Presidential Palace, Railroad Station Palace, and a visit to Tempeliahaukio Church (Lutheran), also known as “Rock Church,” with a view of Sibelius Park. Lunch (*on our own*) and afternoon at leisure. Hotel check-in at the *Scandic Kallio* (or similar). Overnight at our hotel. (B)

DAY 10 – HELSINKI: A full day at leisure offers the opportunity to join an optional excursion to Tallinn, capital of Estonia, known as one of the “Pearls of the Baltic” countries. Tonight, a farewell dinner awaits at your hotel. (B)

DAY 11 – HELSINKI~BOSTON: We will have breakfast and check out at the hotel before departing for the airport for our return flight to Boston (intermediate stop) with meal and beverage service, as well as stereo headsets, available while in flight. (B)
